

HOW CAN YOU OBTAIN CANNABIS PRODUCTS IN FLORIDA?

<p>Low-THC</p> <p>Approved for patients suffering from debilitating medical conditions.</p>	<p>Medical Cannabis</p> <p>Approved for patients suffering from a range of terminal conditions.</p>
<p>Low-THC is currently approved to treat:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cancer • Epilepsy • Chronic seizures • Severe and persistent muscle spasms • Other qualifying conditions 	<p>Your condition must meet one of the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • It creates serious functional impairment; • Your physician considers it irreversible, even with current FDA-approved treatments; • It will be fatal within a year of diagnosis without life-sustaining procedures.
<p>Contains low levels of tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) and high levels of cannabidiol (CBD)</p>	<p>May contain higher levels of cannabidiol (CBD) and tetrahydrocannabinol (THC)</p>
<p>No psychoactive properties</p>	<p>Contains psychoactive properties</p>



- 1) If you are a permanent resident of Florida and after being a patient of a qualified physician for at least 3 months, a physician qualified to dispense medical cannabis must diagnose you with a debilitating or terminal condition that qualifies for either low-THC or medical cannabis (see above for more information on qualifying conditions).
 - i) If you are under 18 and qualify for low-THC, a second physician must agree with the treatment determination.
 - ii) If you suffer from a terminal illness that qualifies for medical cannabis, a second physician that specializes in your condition must agree with the treatment determination.
- 2) You must give your physician voluntary, written and informed consent as required under section 499.0295, Florida Statutes, and then he or she can place an order for your cannabis treatment.
- 3) You can fill your order at any MHC Dispensary or request convenient mobile delivery.
